

Here are some last minute notes for the first day of school, Wednesday, August 5.

Parent Drop Off/Pick Up areas: To avoid the traffic on Forest Avenue, parents may drop off and pick up their students on Fountain Avenue. **No parking is allowed in the cul-de-sacs, please pull forward when dropping your students on the cul-de-sacs.** Please utilize Sinex Avenue below PGMS and Hillcrest Avenue above PGMS for additional student drop off and pick up areas. This will help alleviate the congestion that sometimes occurs on Forest Avenue in front of our school. Thank you for your help.

Bus Riders: The bus is free for the first two weeks of school and bus stops will be based on the addresses of students who sign up. There are additional bus runs for middle and high school students who have early morning first period classes. Bus stop details can be found at pgusd.org under transportation.

Doors Open: Only students who have a first period class are allowed in the building at 7:35 a.m. Students who begin their day with a second period class may enter school at 8:25 a.m. The library opens at 8 a.m. for students who wish to wait there until classes begin. Students are only allowed to gather in back of school near the picnic tables while waiting for the day to begin. No students are allowed to congregate at the front of the campus or near the bike racks.

P.E. Clothes: Students do not need to dress out the first few day of school. P.E. teachers will announce to students when they should bring their P.E. clothes to school. All students must also have proper athletic shoes and hair ties. P. E. lockers will be assigned during the first few days of school.

Materials/Supplies: Students should bring paper, pens, pencils and a binder on the first day of school. Individual teachers will guide students on the class supplies needed for each class.
